

RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 08-10

Passed April 5, 2010

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 18-06, ORDINANCE NUMBER 7-07, AND ORDINANCE NUMBER 24-07 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Genoa desires to make changes in the administrative positions of its parks to better serve the residents of Genoa; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Genoa deems it necessary to repeal Ordinance 18-06 adopted on April 17, 2006; Ordinance 7-07 adopted on March 5, 2007; and Ordinance 24-07 adopted on May 21, 2007 in order to accomplish the necessary administrative position changes.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio does hereby repeal Ordinance 18-06, Ordinance 7-07, and Ordinance 24-07.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the Village of Genoa, and the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village, and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
