Ordinance No. 17-10

Passed May 17, 2010

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER NINETEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$19,000.00) FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (403), INTO MAJOR PROJECTS D-1 FUND (405), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY..

WHEREAS, the Village has debt payment due to the Ohio Public Works Commission from Northwest Sewer Improvements, Phase I and Phase II, made within the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That this Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, Ohio does hereby Authorize the Fiscal Officer to transfer Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) from the Capital Improvements Fund (403.699.5252), into the Major Projects Fund (405.000.4135) as follows:

SECTION 2. It is found and determined all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council or of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3 The passage of this ordinance as an emergency measure is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare in order to permit the Village to comply with the established debt payment schedule.


SECTION 4 This ordinance shall be in full force from and immediately after its passage.
