Ordinance No. 19 - 10

Passed July 6, 2010

AN ORDINANCE REVISING SECTION 935.24 (a) (1), WATER RATES AND FEES, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA TO EFFECT WATER SERVICE FEES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Genoa's Utilities Committee met on May 17, 2010 and has recommend the following adjustment to the Village's water rate structure, and

WHEREAS, the revised water rate structure will assist users on fixed incomes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO.

SECTION 1. That this Council of the Village of Genoa, Ottawa County, does hereby revise Section 935.24 (A) (1), Water Rates and Fees, of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Genoa as follows:

From	First 2,000 gallons or less	\$13.91 (Ord 4-99 passed 12/16/99)
	All succeeding 1,000 gallons	\$ 6.95 (Ord 4-99 passed 12/16/99)
To:	First 1,000 gallons or less	\$10.93
	All succeeding 1,000 gallons	\$10.93

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council or of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. The passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure is necessary in order to assure fair and equitable water rates are charged to the citizens of the Village, therefore preserving of the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the citizens of the Village of Genoa.
