Ordinance No. 25-10

Passed August 2, 2010

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 131, TITLED MAYOR, DESIGNATING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA AS THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY FOR ALL VILLAGE EMPLOYEES SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Genoa desires that the Mayor be the appointing authority for the Village work force;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENOA, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO.

SECTION 1. That Chapter 131, Titled MAYOR, shall be amended to include the following:

131.03 APOINTMENT OF THE WORK FORCE

The Mayor shall be the appointing authority for the Village work force. All personnel hired for positions after the passage of this ordinance, must first be recommended by the Mayor, subject to the approval by a majority of Village Council.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council or of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


