GENOA HOMECOMING 3on3 BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT Rules & Regulations

Player Information & Eligibility

1. A team may have three or four players on its roster. Changes may be made up to the entry deadline by contacting the event coordinator.
2. Players may appear on more than one team, provided they are in different divisions (i.e. an Adult Open team, and a 40+ team). Entry fees still apply for each entry.
3. Team jerseys/matching shirts are recommended, but not required.

Court Boss

1. A Court Boss will be in charge of each court. Court Bosses are volunteers; they are **NOT** professional referees.
2. The Court Boss has absolute authority to control play, overturn fouls, call violations, enforce technical/flagrant/intentional fouls, and, as warranted, eject players for unsportsmanlike conduct. This is a family event. **The Court Boss will call fouls only in the Futures and Jr. High divisions.** In all other divisions, players call their own. A foul called by a player **MAY** be overturned by the Court Boss if deemed blatantly incorrect. The Court Boss has final say.
3. Inappropriate language or behavior directed at players, officials, or fans by a player or spectator will not be tolerated, and may lead to removal from the event. One warning may be given at the discretion of the Court Boss.

Pre-Game

1. Game time is forfeit time. Games will begin at the designated start time, with any number of players (1, 2, or 3).
2. In order to keep the event running smoothly, we ask that a team representative check the schedule periodically. If there is an open court, we will attempt to start another game ahead of schedule.
3. Only teams scheduled to play next will be allowed on each court pre-game.

Game Play

1. Scoring is by 1s and 2s; a) In group play, games are played straight-up to 11 points or a time limit of 20 minutes, whichever comes first. The Court Boss will keep time, score, and team fouls. If the game is tied, it ends in a tie; b) In the playoffs, games are played to 11, win by 2, with a 15-point limit. The 20-minute time limit applies **ONLY** if a team leads by 2 or more points.
2. Each team is allowed one (1) one-minute timeout per game. Timeouts do not count against the 20-minute clock.
3. After EVERY change in possession, the ball must be taken back behind the 2-point line. This means both feet and the ball entirely behind the line. A violation occurs if the team failing to take it back then makes a basket. The basket will not count, and possession is awarded to the opposing team.
4. After every dead ball, the ball will be inbounded from a designated area above the top of the key, AFTER being checked by an opponent. **The ball must be PASSED in.**
5. Jump balls go to the defense.
6. Fouls:
 - a) The Court Boss will call fouls only in the Futures and Jr. High divisions. In all other divisions, players call their own; the Court Boss has final say and may overturn a player-called foul if it is deemed blatantly incorrect.
 - a) Team fouls: on the fifth team foul, the team that was fouled is awarded one free throw worth one point.
 - b) Shooting fouls: if the shot is missed, the team that was fouled will have the option of shooting one or two free throws (equal to the value of the shot), or taking the ball out; if the shot is made, the basket counts and one free throw is awarded.
 - c) Technical/intentional/flagrant fouls: result in two free throws plus possession; count as a team foul. The offending player may be ejected from the game or tournament at the discretion of the Court Boss or Tournament Coordinator.

d) Note on free throws: a team technical foul may be called if it is determined by the Court Boss that the team shooting free throws is purposely stalling to run clock.
