Colorado Blue Spruce: Great for landscapes, colors range from slightly blue-green to marvelous blue. Tolerate to a wide range of soil conditions, grows to an average height of 80 feet.



Norway Spruce: A wonderful windbreak plant, this dense evergreen has short dark green, flat needles. Will grow in most Ohio soils except water soaked. Reaches an average height of 50-60 feet.



American Arborvitae: This beautiful evergreen foliage is frond-like on flat branches varying from dark to light green during the growing season. It is also a great windbreak choice, growing in a pyramid-like shape with a height of 18-45 feet.



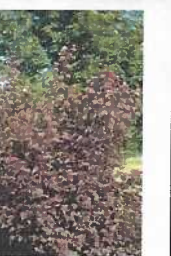
Bald Cypress: This unique evergreen loses its needles each year! Grows in a wide range of soil conditions from wet, swampy areas to dry upland areas. Grows 50 to 70 feet in height.



Green Rocket Cedar: White tail deer resistant with a pleasant cedar like aroma. It has soft foliage and can tolerate drought and most soil conditions. This hybrid can grow 3 feet a year reaching a width of 6 to 10 feet and 25 feet tall.



Autumn Blaze Maple: This extremely fast growing maple has strong branching and turns a brilliant red hue in the fall. Under good conditions it can grow 3 feet a year. It is tolerant of clay soils and drought. (Photo shown with fall colors)



Diablo Ninebark: Prized for its deciduous, colorful deep purple-red foliage in summer with pale pink flower clusters in spring. Can grow 1-3 ft. per year and mature at 8 ft. tall and wide. Prefers moist soil that is not water-logged. It will grow in part shade to full sun.



Red Oak: This is one of the fastest growing oaks, with up to 2' of growth per year. Its leaves are a lustrous dark green in summer and turn a russet red in fall. Tolerant of many urban conditions, but prefers sandy, well-drained soils in full sun. Grows up to 2' per year reaching a height of 60' with a spread of 50' in 10 to 15 years.



Red Osier Dogwood: Thicket-forming shrub that quickly grows to 10 ft. high by 7 to 8 ft. wide. It has small, white flowers that are followed by small, white fruit. In the fall, its foliage turns from green to purple. In the winter, the stems are red, providing a nice contrast to the snow cover. Good cover for birds and wildlife



Exclamation London Plane: Heat and drought tolerant tree that looks similar to a Sycamore. It can grow 5 to 6 feet per year up to 60 feet tall with a 50 foot spread. It has patchy cream & tan bark with dark green leaves to turn yellow-brown in the fall. Tolerates a wide range of soil conditions.



Canada Red Chokecherry: A vigorous and hardier form of Canada Red Chokecherry; Leaves emerge green in spring. It is known for foliage that is a darker reddish purple with a thicker leaf texture. It can grow up to 20 feet tall and 15 foot wide.



American Cranberry: This deciduous shrub can get up to 10-12 feet high and 8 feet wide. Preferring full sun or part shade it has showy white flowers followed by red berries in the fall and winter. Great for wildlife!



Tulip Poplar: This large shade tree can grow up to 80' tall by 40' wide under the best conditions. The Tulip Poplar prefers full sun in deep, rich, moist soil that at times can be wet. This tree is able to get quickly established and grow fast!



Ivory Silk Lilac: This is a tree form lilac with large plumes of small white flowers in early summer. Blooms after all other spring flowering trees have finished blooming. Ivory Silk Lilac grows slowly to 20 ft. tall and 15 ft. wide and will fit into smaller spaces.



Native Tree Pack Options: These custom native packs will contain two of each of the trees listed below. These packs are a great way to start a healthy wildlife habitat!



Wildlife Tree Pack: Swamp White Oak, Am. Hazelnut, Ninebark, Am. Plum, and Black Chokeberry.

Pollinator Tree Pack: Red Osier Dogwood, Chokecherry, American Plum, Meadowsweet, and Pasture Rose

Nut Tree Pack: 3 Hazelnut, 3 Butternut, 2 Northern Pecan, and 2 Black Walnut.
