## Genoa Police Levy

### Exclusively for Police Equipment and Training

YOUR SUPPORT IS NEEDED

Due to a decrease in Federal and State funding the Village of Genoa will seek voter approval for a 2 mill levy. This levy would increase funds necessary to update equipment and provide training for our Genoa Police Department. Some of the anticipated uses of the fund are for:

- **Bullet Proof Vest** – Current vests are reaching their 5 year expiration date and must be replaced.
- **Body Cameras** – Used for Public Safety and Officer accountability.
- **Tasers** – Present Tasers are over 5 years old and no longer serviceable.
- **Patrol Rifles** – Present rifles are military surplus and not applicable for street use.
- **Police Vehicles** – Heavy usage require replacement every two years.
- **Handguns** – Current pistols are over 12 years old and in need of replacement.

This levy is intended to be used exclusively for police equipment / training and is not intended for the use of police salaries. The Genoa Police Department prides itself on its service to the community and would appreciate your support on May 1<sup>st</sup>. The Village would welcome any comments and questions.
